Recurring Roles

Baby Boutique – Spanish-Speaking Support

What: Welcome and support Spanish-speaking community members during our free Baby Boutique Thursdays. Greet families, guide them through our space, and assist with requests for baby items and resources. Children are welcome to join. Conversational fluency in Spanish and English needed. Please inquire about volunteer stipends available for this role.

When: Thursdays, 9:00 am - 3:00 pm (Consistency needed, but flexible shifts and commitment)

Baby Boutique and Resource Pick-Up Support

What: This volunteer role can look different from week to week. In-office volunteers help with organizing and inventorying items and donations in our warehouse and Baby Boutique spaces, data entry, packing orders, greeting families, and prepping for upcoming events.

When: Thursdays, 9:00 am - 3:00 pm (Consistency needed, but flexible shifts and commitment)

Baby Boutique Prep / Resource Pick-Up Support

What: Help prepare for Baby Boutique Thursdays and assist with resource pick-up appointments outside Thursday hours. Tasks include packing family orders, inventorying items, helping transport items to cars, organizing/sorting donations, and keeping the space tidy. Occasional admin or event prep support may also be needed.

When: Monday-Wednesday 9:30 am - 3:30 pm (Consistency needed, flexible shifts and commitment)

Delivery Driver

What: Pickup essential items (diapers, wipes, formula, car seats, etc.) from our partner, West Side Baby, for delivery to our Beacon Hill offices. Reliable vehicle, valid driver's license, and proof of auto insurance required.

When: Pickups on 1st and 3rd Tuesday, 9:30 am - 2:00 pm in West Seattle

Where: Pickup at West Side Baby in White Center, drop-off at our Beacon Hill offices

Resource Scout

What: Help us source essential baby and family items by scouting local Buy Nothing groups, community giveaway pages, and other donation networks. As a Resource Scout, you'll reference our list of Highly Requested Baby Items, arrange pickups with donors, and drop off donations at our office. This role is ideal for someone who enjoys community engagement, has reliable transportation, and wants to make a tangible impact behind the scenes.

When: Flexible schedule, based on your availability and item pickup needs. Most drop-offs occur Monday - Friday between 9:30 am – 3:30 pm.

Where: Pickups will vary; drop-offs at our Beacon Hill offices
